TRIP REQUIREMENTS

1. Must be in grades 9 – 12 during the 2019-2020 school year.
2. Must be an active attendee of the Refuge Youth Ministry.
3. Must agree to pay the full expense of their trip either through their own funds and/or personal fundraising.
4. Must participate and complete pre-trip meetings and assignments. (3-5 meetings)

REGISTRATION PROCESS

There are 20 available spots for youth and four adult leaders (Martins, Melissa Hatfield and Rod Maples, Pastor of Worship). Priority will be given to older youth. If there are available spots, we will open additional spots to youth workers.

September 1-30 // Sign up open at www.refugejc.com/haiti. No deposit required to sign up. Sign up simply means you are committed to going on the trip **IF** you receive one of the 20 spots.

October 1 // Team Selection

October 30 // Deposit of \$250 due online

January 1 // Remaining trip fee of \$615 due online

March 1 // Flight fee paid in full online
